

Get your bulky waste collected - it's free



Broken household goods

- **Furniture** - e.g. tables, chairs, beds, and rugs.
- **Electronics** - e.g. a toaster, radio, and TV screens.
- **White goods** - e.g. a broken washing machine or dishwasher.
- **Iron and metal** - e.g. pots, cutlery, barbecues, and bicycles.



Hazardous waste

- **Painting** - e.g. buckets with remains from painting, varnish, and glue.
- **Batteries and aerosol cans** - e.g. hair spray, household-, tool-, and car batteries.
- **Spray cans** - e.g. hairspray, deodorant, and oil spray.



Plastics and cardboard items

- **Plastics** - e.g. plastic foil, plastic lids, - containers, and - bottles.
- **PVC products** - e.g. bathing pools, armbands, and rubber boots.
- **Cardboard items** - e.g. storage boxes, large cardboard boxes, and corrugated paper.

You cannot get e.g. your garden waste, residual waste, bricks, tiles and mortar collected. Find more information www.kredslob.dk/bulkywaste

How to order pick-up for your bulky waste

- Order the truck for pick-up on www.kredslob.dk/bulkywaste.
- In the booking, you will get information about, when the truck will be at your place.
- Sort small items in clear bags/sacks. Bundle up large cardboard items. Mark bikes, pushchairs, and prams with "Storskrald" (bulky waste in Danish).
- Place the bulky waste outside of where you live. At the earliest the evening before. At the latest by 6 am on the day of collection.



If you have bits and bobs which others can make use of, then consider handing it in for reuse at the recycling station, REUSE or in a second-hand shop. Or give it away on the internet.
